

Our History



Allan Scott

In 1946 Allan Scott bought a three-tonne truck and began transporting grain, hay and livestock in the town of Milang, South Australia. Allan relocated to Mt.Gambier in 1952, offering customers a simple promise: the safe, on-time delivery of their goods.

As his reputation grew, so did the business. By the early 21st century, he had overseen the growth of the Scott Group of Companies – incorporating Scott Corporation Limited and K&S Corporation Limited – into a transport empire stretching across the nation.

Allan Scott, who was awarded the Order of Australia, in part for his focus on truck driver safety training, sadly passed away in 2008. Today, the trucking magnate's dedication to safe transport lives on at the company which bears his name.

Scott Corporation Limited (Scott Corporation) has its origins in three of Australia's most successful transport businesses: Heggies Transport, Bulkhaul and Chemtrans.

The family company Heggies Transport Pty Ltd was created in the NSW Illawarra region around the 1930s and later became responsible for transporting coal for BHP – something Scott Corporation continues to do today.

In 1993, Heggies merged with Bulkhaul, another bulk transport company based in Camden, and listed on the Australian Stock Exchange to create Heggies Bulkhaul Limited. Finally, in 1998, Heggies Bulkhaul purchased Chemtrans, the leading name in transport and logistics for dangerous goods.

Allan Scott's private company, AA Scott Pty Limited, took a majority shareholding in Heggies Bulkhaul in 2003, which later changed its name to Scott Corporation in 2005.

Scott Corporation

Scott Corporation is a truly national carrier with unrivalled expertise in the transport of bulk solids and liquids by road, rail and sea.

Our three operating divisions cater for a diverse range of transport and logistics needs. Chemtrans carries dangerous acids, liquids and chemicals and other specialist goods. Bulktrans carries dry bulk goods, including coal, agricultural and waste products. Whilst Hyde Park Tank Depot is a one-stop-shop for tanker cleaning and repairs.

Chemtrans

Chemtrans offers nationwide transport and logistics for the full range of dangerous and hazardous chemicals, liquids and explosives as well as gas, cement and liquid food. We have an extensive fleet of road, rail and sea tankers for the transport of all classes of dangerous and hazardous goods.

Safety lies at the heart of all that we do, from our risk assessments to our comprehensive staff training.

The products we handle require the utmost respect and our experience and equipment ensure safe delivery anywhere in Australia. We operate a fleet of Emergency Response Vehicles across the country and our own cleaning facilities to ensure tanks are contamination-free.

As a company that truly understands the end to end requirements of dangerous and hazardous goods logistics – we provide auditing and site inspections to our customers, ensuring that all parties associated with the supply chain comply with the chain of responsibility legislation.

Chemtrans is the carrier of choice in Australia for all major companies in the chemical industry. With a focus on in-full on-time delivery, we provide transport and storage services for all major domestic and international manufacturers, importers and consumers of dangerous and hazardous goods.



Our Services

Chemtrans offers specialised transport for the movement of gases such as Chlorine, Anhydrous Ammonia and Vinyl Chloride amongst many other hazardous goods. We also transport products such as Nitric Acid, Sulphuric Acid, Hydrochloric Acid and Caustic Soda. We offer additional services such as dangerous goods container storage in all states plus the ability to undertake decanting of vessels containing dangerous and hazardous goods.

Chemtrans also offers complementary logistics services such as warehousing, project management and supplying additional equipment. Plus, our staff provide advice to clients on issues ranging from plant and equipment set-up to safety training.

As well as transporting hazardous goods, we transport non-hazardous products through our three sub-divisions of Gastrans, Flowtrans and Foodtrans:

Gastrans offers specialised transport for gas products including liquid petroleum gas (LPG), anhydrous ammonia and vinyl chloride monimor.

Flowtrans provides nationwide haulage for cement, lime, sand and other materials which require a pneumatic tanker.

Foodtrans delivers bulk liquid food supplies nationwide using specialised road tankers and ISO tanks. Our unrivalled safety record and innovative techniques has made us the market leader in the transport and storage of dangerous and hazardous bulk liquids

Our reputation for the safe, innovative and reliable transport of bulk materials stretches back over 50 years

Bulktrans has specialised in bulk solid logistics for over fifty years. We operate in every category of dry bulk product, transporting coal, minerals, scrap metal, excavated material, waste products and construction supplies, plus a range of agricultural products, including grain and fertiliser.

While our historical base is NSW, as opportunities arise we are expanding to other states, leveraging our extensive national network as a footprint for growth.

We are proud to have some of the biggest players in the national mining and manufacturing industries on our contract register, with many of these clients being partners for many years.

We have an extensive company owned fleet that caters to bulk solid transport. This includes B-doubles, rigid truck and trailer combinations, semi trailers, tipping skels, bulk containers and numerous bulk and break bulk handling equipment. We also operate highly specialised off road equipment specifically designed for high payload mining applications.

To provide our clients with the safest and most efficient logistics, we harness new ideas and the latest technology offerings. We are accredited nationally under the High Mass Limits scheme for payload maximisation. IAP GPS tracking devices are installed for freight tracking and scheduling optimisation. We also utilise automated load covering systems to eliminate working at heights risks. The use of park brake alarms are a standard specification, as well as numerous equipment enhancements that have provided lower cost outcomes for our clients.

Our Services

Bulktrans, is dedicated to providing innovative, national bulk solid logistics. As well as transporting bulk solid goods by road and rail, we also offer a range of other related services including:

- Stockpile management and on-site logistics;
- Loading and handling
- Stock tracking and reporting
- Environmental controls such as water carts and sweepers

Unique to our extensive branch structure in the Illawarra is a warehousing and distribution business which provides logistics to the steel, shipping and manufacturing industries. The array of services on offer include flat top and containerised transport, floats for heavy and wide loads and extendable trailers for long loads. We also offer a commercial size wash bay for import equipment cleaning, AQIS inspection and quarantine services and extensive yard storage facilities.



Hyde Park Tank Depot

Hyde Park provides the full range of cleaning, repairs and modifications to both the ISO tank container and road tanker industries. Our strong team and integrated tank depot enable us to keep turnaround time to a minimum without compromising on quality. Our container tracking system also increases our reliability by providing real-time status updates.

Washing takes place according to the highest accreditation standards, providing carriers with confidence that their equipment will not be compromised. Tankers are cleaned in a drive-through facility where a motor-controlled, high-pressure cleaning apparatus ensures total coverage of tank interiors. We also provide steam heating of loaded tanks with the capacity for five tanks to be heated at once.

Our repair facility operates within client-specific repair criteria or to International Tank Container Organisation (ITCO) standards. Our surveyors are also trained to Institute of International Container Lessors (IICL) standards.

Our procedures are also constantly updated as we develop new solutions to make transport safer, from our fatigue management training system to the automatic load covers on our bulk tipping fleet which help to reduce fall injuries.

Scott Corporation is accredited for all relevant modules of the National Heavy Vehicle Accreditation Scheme including, Mass Management, Maintenance Management and Fatigue Management.

Additional accreditation includes the Plastics and Chemicals Association (PACIA), Truck Safe and the Basic Fatigue Management scheme.

Independent assesment and accreditation ensures we are fully compliant with all relevant laws and regulations, enabling us to operate more efficiently with improved utilisation and flexibility.



Staff Training and Testing

New drivers undergo a training program of up to six-weeks, led by our full-time driver trainers, and update their skills on an ongoing basis. Drivers also undergo medical, psychometric and drug and alcohol testing.

Quality Equipment

We utilise only the best vehicles and highest quality protective gear, including Chemical Splash Suits.

Constant Monitoring

Our driver trainers and compliance officers address the full range of safety issues across our business. All safety, health and environmental issues are proactively managed by our national Safety Council, National SH&E Manager and state based Compliance Officers under the direction of the Board of the Safety Sub-Committee.

Emergency Response

Located across the country, our Emergency Response Vehicles provide trained staff with specialist equipment in the event that an incident does occur. Emergencies can be called in through our national emergency response number.

Take 2 Before You Do

The Take 2 Before You Do process helps our employees to minimise hazards by reminding them to stop and consider what could happen next. Previously targeted only at drivers, Scott Corporation has now relaunched the program for our entire workforce. We have made a total commitment to strengthening awareness of the Take 2 principles.

Our Chemtrans division operate fit for purpose equipment suitable for all types of Dangerous and Hazardous Goods for road, rail and sea. The fleet consists of single tanker units right up to the quad road trains.


